Tuition

Tuition for Leadership Clemson is \$200, payable to the City. The cost of tuition covers all meals, transportation and session materials.

Attendance

Due to the limited number of classes and the information covered during each session, attendance is mandatory for all classes in order to be considered a graduate.

Class Project

Each year Leadership Clemson takes on a class project. A project that will hopefully leave a lasting impact. The project allows participants to utilize their leadership skills to select, organize, and complete an initiative that makes a tangible difference in the Clemson Community. Projects must be completed by June 30th and although time is allotted during each session for project discussion, it may be necessary for the class to meet outside of normal session days and times in order to complete the project.

Scholarships
