

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CLEMSON CITY COUNCIL  
ESTABLISHING A STORMWATER USER FEE**

WHEREAS, The City of Clemson (hereinafter the ("City")), is mandated by applicable law to address the requirements of the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) permit program requirements as administered by the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC); and

WHEREAS, the City is responsible for stormwater management within its municipal boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the City desires that effective stormwater management be provided to its citizens to protect, to the extent practicable, from the loss of life and property damage from flooding, and to minimize, to the extent practicable, impacts to surface water quality from runoff; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to implement a stormwater user fee to be used to fund the operation, construction and maintenance of stormwater facilities and equipment, stormwater system planning, quality control operations and review of development plans for compliance with stormwater management codes; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to provide a fair, equitable and dependable source of funds for it to fund the stormwater utility in a manner that complies with state requirements,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CLEMSON, SOUTH CAROLINA that a Residential Equivalency Unit be established at four dollars (\$4.00) per month for the purposes of calculating user charges as described in the Stormwater Management Ordinance of the City of Clemson, as cited in City Code, Chapter 11, Article V, Section 172.
