

**AN AGREEMENT FOR EXCHANGE OF POLICE DISPATCH SERVICES BETWEEN  
THE CITY OF CLEMSON AND THE TOWN OF CENTRAL**

This agreement is entered into this 1st day of July, 2016 by and between the City of Clemson and the Town of Central Police Department.

**I. STATEMENT OF AGREEMENT**

The City of Clemson agrees to provide certain limited services to the Town of Central, and the Town of Central agrees to reimburse the City of Clemson for services received in accordance with the terms of this agreement.

**II. LEGAL BASIS**

The provisions of Title 5-7-60, South Carolina Code of Laws 1976, as amended authorize this agreement.

**III. GENERAL SERVICES DEFINED**

The City of Clemson agrees to provide police dispatch services for the Town of Central Police Department to include all services as related to law enforcement communications and defined with this agreement.

The Town of Central Police Department agrees to reimburse the City of Clemson for the cost of dispatching services at a monthly rate as defined below. The Clemson Police Department will be responsible for invoicing the Town of Central on a monthly basis in accordance with the following schedule of payments

July 2016 through June 2017	\$ 5,050	per month
July 2017 through June 2018	\$ 5,300	per month
July 2018 through June 2019	\$ 5,565	per month

**IV. DELIVERY OF SERVICES**

- A. The City of Clemson agrees to provide the Town of Central Police Department dispatch services on an annual basis twenty-four hours per day.
- B. The Clemson Police Department agrees to fulfill all NCIC requirements and provide those services to the Central Police Department.
- C. The Clemson Police Department agree to be responsible for telephone answering and forwarding messages to Central Police Officers during non-business hours and other times when the Town of Central Town Hall is not in operation.
- D. The Clemson Police Department and the City of Clemson agrees to maintain the radio repeater located at the Clemson House whereas the Town of Central agrees to maintain a second radio repeater and emergency generator located at the water tower in the Town of Central.

E. The Clemson Police Department agrees to provide available computer aided dispatching reports to Central Police Officers upon request.

V. LIABILITY

A. The Town of Central shall be responsible for any liability arising due to negligence or misconduct of Central Police Officers.

B. The City of Clemson shall be responsible for any liability arising due to negligence or misconduct of the City of Clemson Police Officers and civil employees.

VI. This agreement will take effect July 1, 2016 and shall continue until terminated by either party.

VII. TERMINATION

This agreement may be terminated at any time by either party upon one hundred twenty (120) day written notice to the other party of its intention to withdraw.

VIII. RENEWAL

Unless terminated or renewed under new terms and/or conditions, this agreement will be renewed automatically for successive terms of one (1) year, beginning July 1<sup>st</sup> of each calendar year.

IX. EXECUTION: This agreement has been duly considered and passed by the City Council of the City of Clemson, South Carolina and the Town Council of the Town of Central, South Carolina, and authority is hereby granted for execution by the Mayor of each municipality.
