From Highway 123, take the Issaqueena Trail exit and go toward Pendleton.

From Highway 123, go approximately ½ mile. The road will fork, and you will take the left fork.

Go approximately ¼ mile and W. C. Nettles Park is on the left.

From the intersection of Highway 123 and Highway 76, take Highway 76 toward Anderson.

At the first traffic light, turn right onto Perimeter Road.

Stay on Perimeter Road to the first traffic light and turn left onto Cherry Road.

Stay on Cherry Road and take the first right turn onto Old Stadium Road.

The Conference Center and Inn will be ahead on the left side of the road.

### **Home Run Derby** – Friday, July 17, 8:00 pm – W.C. Nettles Park

#### **Rules:**

- Each team will select one player to participate.
- Any ball hit over the outfield fence in the air in fair territory will be a home run.
- Each participant will get five outs; a swing will count as an out unless the ball is hit for a home run.
- Each participant must provide his own ADULT pitcher, an L-screen will be provided.
- All bats must be Dixie Youth approved; no big barrel bats.
- The player that hits the most home runs will be the winner. In the event of a tie, all players that are tied will get three more outs. We will continue until a winner is determined.
- Central-Clemson tournament staff and volunteers will be in charge of all events. Any rulings or penalties enforced are final. This event is meant to be a fun time for everyone involved.





Note: Tournament Director with the WRITTEN consent of all team managers may change the time or assigned games if it is done before the tournament starts. Drawings must determine original pairings.


