

2014-R-10 ZONING TEXT AMENDMENT - SECTION 19-704 TEMPORARY SIGNS EXEMPT FROM PERMIT REQUIREMENTS – POLITICAL CAMPAIGNS

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE VII, SIGN REGULATIONS, SECTION 19-704 TEMPORARY SIGNS EXEMPT FROM PERMIT REQUIREMENT TO ADD STANDARDS FOR POLITICAL CAMPAIGNS.

To amend Section 19-704. Temporary Signs Exempt from Permit Requirement to add standards for political campaigns as follows:

- I. Political Campaign and Related Signs. Temporary signs not exceeding **12 square feet in area in residentially districts and not to exceed 20 square feet in nonresidential districts, may be** placed on private real property with the consent of the property owner or possessor of the private real property. Signs shall be removed **within 7 days** of Election Day. A political campaign includes a primary, general, or special election, as well as any runoff elections. Signs placed in the public right-of-way, including unimproved street rights-of-way, shall be subject to removal and destruction by the Zoning and Codes Administrator **or designee** without notice.
